

YOUTH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

1. Question for Amanda: How has Homework Help and Handout Friday been going?

- Homework Help and Hangout Friday have been going well! Parents call often to find out more information as they are noticing positive progress. We have been getting excellent feedback and it's been truly wonderful getting to know the kids. Here is the breakdown of each meeting day:
